

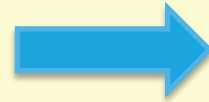

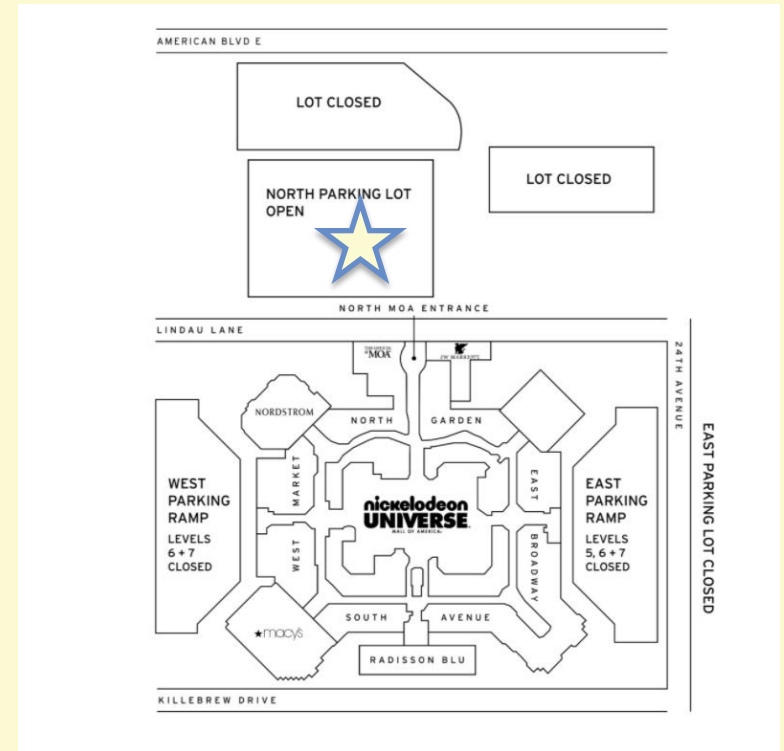

This year, the festival will be a “park and participate” event. We will get out of our car to enjoy the activities at the festival.



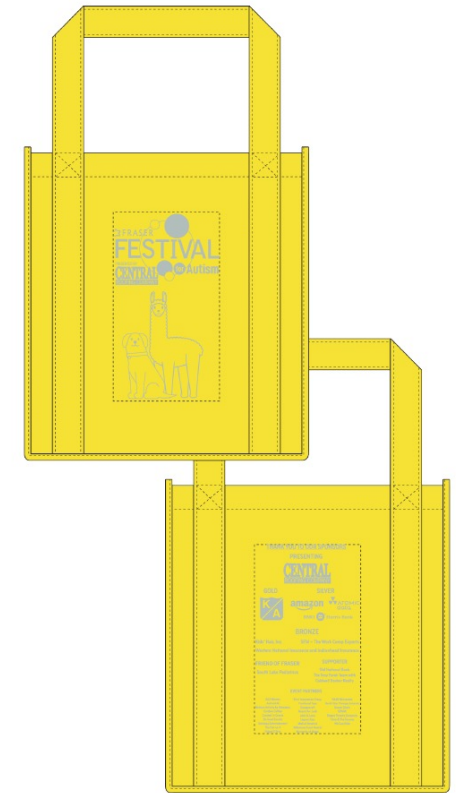
Safety

I will see people wearing masks and gloves at the event. This helps everyone stay healthy and safe. I can ask an adult if I should wear a mask, too.

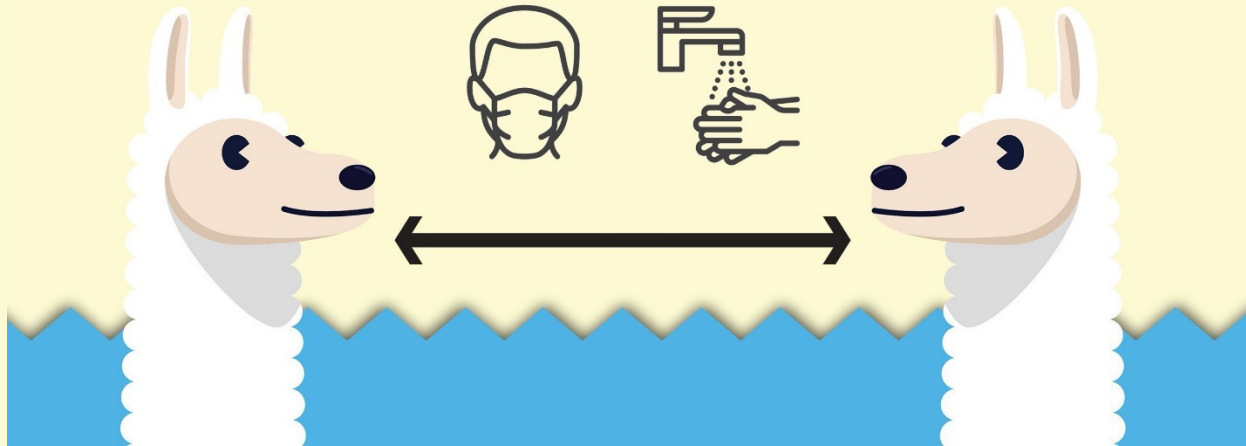


Tote Bags

Bathroom

Activities

Sensory Support

If I am feeling overwhelmed, I can find someone in an orange Sensory Support shirt. They have backpacks with tools in them to help me feel calm so I can have fun at the event. I can also visit a sensory tent to take a break from the event.

When the event is over, the person I came with will help me decide if we are going to go inside Mall of America or if we are going to leave.
